

ART HIRAHARA – CENTRAL LINE

Art Hirahara is a
beautifully fluid pianist
– one who really won
us over with his last
album on Posi-tone,
and who seems to
soar even more here
– working in a
fantastic trio that
includes Linda Oh on
bass and Rudy
Royston on drums –

plus some occasional tenor from Donny McCaslin! Oh and Royston have this round presence that really resonates strongly with Art's piano – creating this wave of soulful energy from the ground up, even on the mellower moments – with a tonal depth that's sophisticated, yet never forced at all. When McCaslin comes into the mix, his sound is a bit more separate from the three – yet in a way that only underscores their cohesion and beautiful sensitivity together. Titles include "Little Giant", "Sensitive Animal", "Central Line", "Kuroda Bushi", "Astray", and a version of the Chico Buarque tune "As Minhas Meninas". ~ Dusty Groove
